

Announcement 2015

Expected timetable – subject to change.

We expect our non-resident guests to arrive at the boathouse of the *Karls-ruher Rheinklub Alemannia* on **Friday 19th June 2015** from 4pm onwards. There will be the opportunity to get to know each other, chat, eat (including barbeque) and drink as well as prepare the boats and clarify any organisational questions.

Overnight accommodation will be provided in the boathouse – please bring your own sleeping bag and air mattress. Sleepers will be divided depending on how loud they snore! At 3:45am you will be woken by the aroma of fresh coffee and other tasty morsels (as well as by the noise of your colleagues).

A hearty breakfast will be provided, where you can also collect your packed lunch and finalise preparations for the start. There will be little time to spare as the first stroke of around 20000 for the day will begin at sunrise on **Saturday 20th June (5:19am** summertime). The course begins with a 3km warm-up through the harbour where it meets the Rhein at kilometre 360. Each crew can row until **sunset at 9:36pm** at the latest. Wherever you end up – in Worms, Mainz or the Loreley, the baggage and crew shuttle bus will meet you before you have had time to remove the riggers.

After a hard day's work, we offer the additional option to support a speedy journey home: food and accommodation at the *Mainzer Ruder-Gesellschaft* followed by transportation back to Karlsruhe on **Sunday 21st June**.

For the **registration fee** of **50€** (until 9.5.) we offer an evening meal on Friday and Saturday, breakfast on Saturday, Accommodation in Karlsruhe and all boat and crew transport and logistics. Not to forget a souvenir! All that is not covered are travel to and from Karlsruhe, and any drinks in the evenings.

Rowing will take place in C-category gig boats with covering, and the new "Kirchboot" of the LRVBW.

The registration form will be open from March. For registration after the 10^{th} May the fees will increase to $60 \in$. Registration closes without exception on the **31**st May.
